We were able to start an Educational endowment fund last year. Now, we support 7 boys for college education. The need has increased while our commitments have grown too.

During the month of August and September, Hope House International will be involved in Annie Bs fund drive along with North Valley Community foundation.

When you make a donation to Hope House International through the Annie B's Community Drive, you can take advantage of an incredible grant program from North Valley Community Foundation (NVCF). As an Annie B's donor, you also join a community-wide effort that involves hundreds of nonprofits and thousands of donors in cooperative effort.

It is this spirit of cooperation and working together as a community that will help us serve the Orphans around the world.

North Valley Community Foundation has committed to granting a projected \$100,000 this year to local nonprofits. In order to receive a portion of these funds Hope House International needs to raise money from our organization's friends from August 1 through September 30. These donations will be sent to NVCF earmarked for Hope House International programs.

One hundred percent of the money raised for Hope House International through Annie B's Community Drive will go to our programs . After September 30, NVCF will tally the total amount raised by all participating nonprofits and determine the percentage grant amounts that will be added to the funds we raise.

Money raised during the Annie B's Community Drive will go into our Educational Endowment Fund. The Endowment Fund is an opportunity for community members to help us build a permanent source of funding for our efforts. Funds in our endowment are invested and only a percentage is used annually.
